On April 26, 2007 the official press conference for [SVIAZ/EXPO COMM MOSCOW 2007](#) was held at Expocentr, Krasnaya Presnya Fairgrounds. About 60 journalists from press and media attended the conference.

The deputy General Director of Expocentr Nikolay Gusev stated that this year [over 600 exhibitors from 33 countries](#) will occupy [around 20.000 sqm](#). There will be [over 400 exhibitors from Russia and more than 200 international companies](#). National Pavilions will be organized from Germany, Italy, France, Spain, China, Taiwan, Korea and the US.

The organizers Expocentr and E.J. Krause & Associates put more emphasis on the [B2B format](#) this year .

More added value will support the exhibitors to achieve their goals. The business program will include an international [conference "The Russian Telecom Opportunity"](#), seminars, presentations and round tables. On the show floor there will be a [Presentation Area](#) divided into thematic days of IP, Wireless, Cable & Satellite Communications and IT Enterprise Solutions.

[New services](#) will be provided to the exhibitors and visitors at SVIAZ/EXPO COMM MOSCOW 2007: Match Making, Business Center, Internet Café. Traditionally the Information Center will be available.

Thus the show is being transformed in its format and is following the new industry trends.

Also at this years event the Russian System of Communication and Navigation [GLONASS](#), which should become operational in January 2008, will be presented. Its precision will be comparable with the GPS Global Positioning System. The GLONASS system was developed in the framework of a Federal Program "Global Navigation System" which is coordinated by the First Deputy Prime Minister Sergey Ivanov.

In his letter of support for SVIAZ/EXPO COMM MOSCOW he states that "the show has become the largest forum in the field of the High Technology and creates favorable conditions for mutual beneficial cooperation between domestic and international manufacturers of telecommunications equipment and services, exchange of advanced scientific findings and innovations".
